Discover:

Learn about the surrounding landscape and river system as a larger entity, including the Darling Scarp, the Kings Park dunes, and the spring line at the base of the Tamala at the contact with the Kings Park shale. Aspects discussed will include:

- The two deep paleochannels in the Swan River from the last ice age, of which piles from the Narrow's bridge are located
- The migmatites and gneisses around the bridge abutments
- The context of the various guarries up on the scarp
- Darling Fault and regional seismicity
